Tarrytown Pharmacy is equipped with four types of refrigerated storage boxes including: simple dorm-style high capacity holding fridges, medical-grade fridges, a single deep-freeze storage unit, and a vaccine fridge that holds about \$40,000 of pharmaceuticals at any given time. The loss of monitoring the specified temperatures for these refrigerated storage boxes can result in the financial loss of inventory, the use of pharmaceuticals that have potentially been exposed to out-of-range temperatures which could harm patients and result in legal action that would be costly and damaging to a pharmacy.

Solution: Considering the value of medications in pharmacy refrigerators, the use of a temperature monitoring system can serve as insurance against costly inventory loss due to equipment failure, as well as keeping in conjunction with regulatory compliance due to inconsistent data logging.
